To our School and to Italy

We are delighted to inform you about the Italian educational system about our school.



Lessons start in september and finish in june of the following year. To start school in september, you need to enrol in january (9 months before). If you have just come to Italy, **you must enrol as soon as you arrive even if the school-year has already started**. Remember that **all kids have the right to go to school even if their stay permission is not according our rules** (We respect the UNO International Convention about the Rights of Children)



School in Italy



School is compulsory from 6 to 16.

Our educational system:


Nursery school	until 3	Not compulsory	
Infant School	from 3 to 6	Not compulsory But advisable	

School is compulsory for 10 years:

1st cycle of education lasts for 8 years
It ends with a final exam which is very important for your future. The 1st cycle consists of:

Primary School	from 6 to 11	
Lower Secondary School (middle school)	from 11 to 14	

**2nd cycle of education lasts from 3 to 5 years.
The first two years are compulsory**

Upper Secondary School (you choose...)	from 14

Where to enrol

Enrolment must be completed at the Staff Offices of the School which are placed at 5 Piazza Castello in SALIZZOLE (VR) from Monday to Saturday from 8.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.

Documents necessary for your enrolment

Parents are requested to fill in the documents which are given by the School

Forms to be filled in contain:

- The type of school (infant, primary or secondary)
- Your option may be for the Catholic Religion subject (if you want your child to attend the subject), or for other activities in the place of C.R.;
- The choice about the time you want your children to stay at school
 - For the Infant School from 4 to 8 hours a day
 - For the Primary School from 27 to 30 hours a week
 - For the Lower Secondary School from 29 to 33 hours a week
- Your option for lunch meal at school;

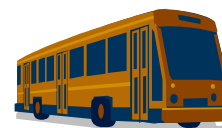


Useful information:

- Lunch meals are supplied by the Municipal Administration of Salizzole for the Secondary School and by the Municipal Administration of Bovolone for the Infant School. If you want your lunch meals at school you have to pay for and to address to the school staff offices in Salizzole.

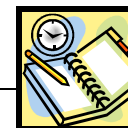


- Parents who start work early in the morning, can ask the Principal for an earlier school entrance (at 7.45 a.m.) For further information please ask the school staff
- You can also have a bus service but you must pay for it. For detailed information about cost and stops please go to your Town Hall offices.



Rules and regulations

Secondary School/Middle School (Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday)	8.00	13.00
Secondary School (Tuesday and Friday with lunch meals and caring after lunch)	8.00	16.30 (option: 33 hours)

- Students are usually assigned some homework to do in the afternoon.
- After each absence pupils are accepted to school with a justification signed by parents
- When a student comes to school later or has to come out earlier he must be accompanied by a parent who will fill in a form
- After 5 days' absence, to be accepted to school, you must have a **certification written by your family doctor saying that the student is fully recovered**
- Parents are asked to check the personal booklet and sign any communication
- Families are requested to communicate to the School their phone number; in case of a new phone number a soon communication will be much appreciated.
- Personal cleanliness is of great importance

Parents and teachers' meetings

Parents are invited to school meetings to have information about their children's behaviour.

School meetings are important because school and family are to work together for successful education.
